C. Changes/Amendment:

Additions, deletions and/or alterations to this MoU may be affected by way of addendum in writing by the Parties to this MoU concerning the changes. Documents containing such additions, deletions and/or alterations and signed by the Parties shall form addenda to this MoU and be deemed to be part of this MoU.

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D. Confidentiality:

1. Parties agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Parties as being confidential which is obtained from either Party or created during the performance of the Agreement and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Party.

E. Termination:

The duration of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), shall be remained unless and until terminated by either of the party after giving three (3) months prior notice in written, if there is failure/ breach of understanding or default by other Party other than on force majeure grounds, provided that any such termination shall not affect any scheme/project which has not been fully completed at such time, unless the Parties agree otherwise in writing.

F. Limitation of Liability

Neither Party shall be liable to the other Party for any Indirect, Incidental, consequential or special damages, including but not limited to loss of profits, loss of investment, loss of opportunities, and loss of goodwill or reputation. At the time of termination neither Party shall be liable to other hereunder nor in relation hereto for more than the fees paid, including the amounts invoiced but not yet paid.

H. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

This MoU shall be governed by and constructed in accordance with the laws of India.

Memorandum of Understanding

Therefore, Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management and Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology agree to establish programs for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (hereinafter MoU).

OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

The goal of this cooperation is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for global experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge, best efforts and frequent interactions. Both the parties agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaboration and the objectives of this MoU are:

- b) Joint organization of seminars, conferences, workshops and short-term continuing education programs, while extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate therein;
- c) All seminars, workshops, training programs and classes would be conducted in virtual class rooms/virtual auditorium and the teachers will teach the students through video conferencing/webcasting.
- d) Both institutions would organize seminar/conference/workshops
- e) Both institutions would submit Joint proposal and would by engaged in teaching or training programmes. While extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate therein;
- f) To promote interaction between both the institutions in mutually beneficial areas which so far have not been identified above

SCOPE OF MOU

Cooperation shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of the competent authority of Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management and Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology through such activities or programmes as:

- Exchange of faculty members
- Exchange of students
- Joint research project and development activities
- Participation and organization of international and national seminars, conference, workshop and academic meetings
- Publication of academic materials, research journal, academic books, news letter, magazine and other information
- Design of special short-term academic programs having national importance
- Exchange of Administrative Managers Coordinators
- Joint cultural Programmes

PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

RECOGNISING the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, education, training, transfer of technology and dissemination of knowledge on long term non-commercial basis, and

RECOGNISING the importance of institutes of higher education's role in promoting international collaboration and increased contribution of social development.

HEREBY agree to establish collaboration according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder.

ARTICLE 1-FIELD OF CO-OPERATION

- 1. Cooperation between the two institutions may be established within any field related to academic and research of mutual interest and extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present MoU, if needed.
- 2. Both institutes recognize that subsequent discussion will be needed to identify priorities and resources for the accomplishment of the goals laid out in this MoU
- 3. Subsequent programs may be made in any fields mutually agreed upon by the authority
- 4. Subsequent agreements may be negotiated and established for the implementation of specific cooperative programs.

ARTICLE 2-EXCHANGE OF FACULTY:

a) Anwarul Uloom College of Business Management and Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology will encourage collaboration in research areas of mutual interest. Anwarul Uloom college of Business Management and Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology will welocom faculties/officers to visit eachothers' colleges to engage in academic and scientific research. Both institutions agree to seek financial support for cooperative activities from appropriate funding agencies. Proposals concerning the topics, persons and periods of visits will be sent within a reasonable time in advance of the proposed visit.

ARTICLE 3- CONDUCT OF CLASS:

- 1. This MoU provides opportunities for the conduct of classes in order to carry out studies as provided for in this MoU. All seminars, workshops, training programs and classes would be conducted in virtual class rooms/virtual auditorium and the teachers will teach the students through video conferencing/webcasting.
- 2. The training course will be organized in virtual classes. Supplementary curriculum materials and in-class activities will be reviewed and resources supporting continuing education will be presented.
- 3. Anwarul Uloom College of Business Management and Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology will work collaboratively to develop a series of educational presentations/ materials.

ARTICLE 4-RESEARCH PROJECTS:

- 1. Efforts will be made to share information about ongoing research activities in order to establish contacts and collaboration between professionals working within the same field.
- 2. Research Projects and the composition of research teams will be approved by the participating institutions. Efforts will be made to evaluate the need for participating staff and the location of the research activity.
- 3. Every research project will have a team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status.

ARTICLE 5- JOINT CONFERENCES, WORKSHOPS AND SHORT-TERM COURSES

Anwarul Uloom College of Business Management and Nawab Shah Alam Khan College of Engineering & Technology agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the invited faculty member(s) and the institution extending such an invitation. When a faculty member visits

the other institution on invitation or as part of such joint activity, then such a visit will be classified as such, and handled as per rules of individual institution.

ARTICLE 6-INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

- 1. Each party will ensure appropriate protection of Intellectual Property Rights generated from cooperation pursuant to MOU, consistent with their respective laws, rules and regulations and agreements to which both parties are committed.
- 2. In case research is carried out solely and separately by the Party or the research results are obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, the party concerned alone will apply for grant of IPR and once granted, the IPR will be solely owned by the concerned party.
- 3. In case research results obtained through joint activities, the grant of intellectual property rights will be sought by the parties jointly and once granted these rights will be jointly owned by the parties.
- 4. The Parties shall not assign any rights and obligations arising out of the IPR generated to inventions/activities carried out under the MOU to any third Party without consent of the other party.
- 5. In case of research results obtained through joint activities under this MOU, both parties will apply as co-applicants for the protection of intellectual property rights subject to exclusive rights of both the Parties to commercialize the technology in their respective areas.

ARTICLE 7-TERMINATION OF MoU

 - 6. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 1. The first party will have the sole rights on the curriculum and related content provided in the trainings and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of the first party.
- 2. Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 1. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this
- 2. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU

could be dissolved or cancelled by either party any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature, should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon, the MOU loses its validity.

- 3. In case research results obtained through joint activities, the grant of intellectual property rights will be sought by the parties jointly and once granted these rights will be jointly owned by the parties.
- 4. The Parties shall not assign any rights and obligations arising out of the IPR generated to inventions/activities carried out under the MOU to any third Party without consent of the other party.
- 5. In case of research results obtained through joint activities under this MOU, both parties will apply as co-applicants for the protection of intellectual property rights subject to exclusive rights of both the Parties to commercialize the technology in their respective areas.

- 1. First Party is a Management College: AUCBM (Anwarul Uloom College of Business Management
- 2. Second Party is Higher Educational Institution named: Srinivasa Institute of Management Studies (SIMS)
- 3. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- 4. The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- 5. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- 6. AUCBM would work with incubation centers/innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis). to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party
- 7. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations.





CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 1. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the trainings to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development
- 3. Skill Development Programs: First Party to train the students of second Party on the emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 4. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 5. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 6. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 1. The first party will have the sole rights on the curriculum and related content provided in the trainings and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of the first party.
- Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 1. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this agreement
- 2. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU

could be dissolved or cancelled by either party any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature, should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

1. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
