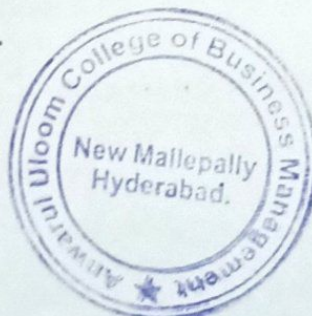
Composition of the Green Campus Committee:

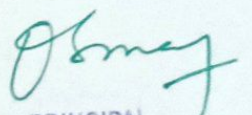
Committee consisting of following members has been constituted to ensure proper and effective implementation of the objectives of having the Green Campus.

1. Restricted entry of automobiles:

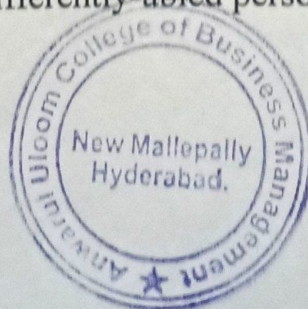

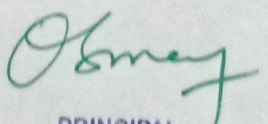
2. Ban on use of Plastic:

4. Pedestrian friendly pathways:

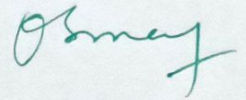

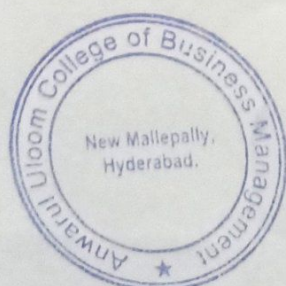
