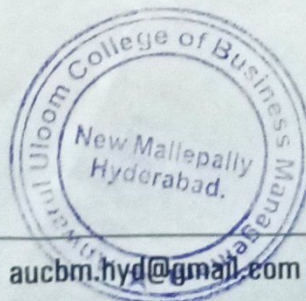
Scope: This policy applies to all students, faculty, staff, and visitors of Anwarul Uloom College of Business Management and all college operations and activities.

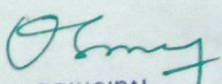
Anwarul Uloom College of Business Management is committed to promoting environmental sustainability and energy conservation on our campus. To achieve this goal, the institute follows:

- Addressing waste management and encouraging recycling, composting and reducing the use of plastic.

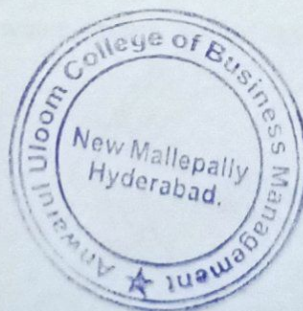

Pedestrian Friendly pathways

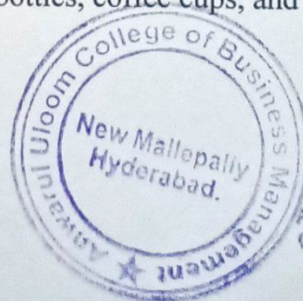

- Waste reduction campaigns: Colleges may also promote waste reduction campaigns, such as encouraging the use of reusable water bottles, coffee cups, and bags.

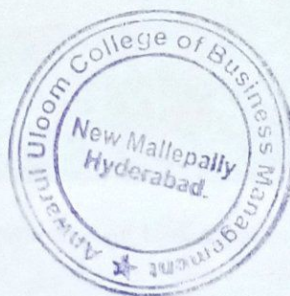
